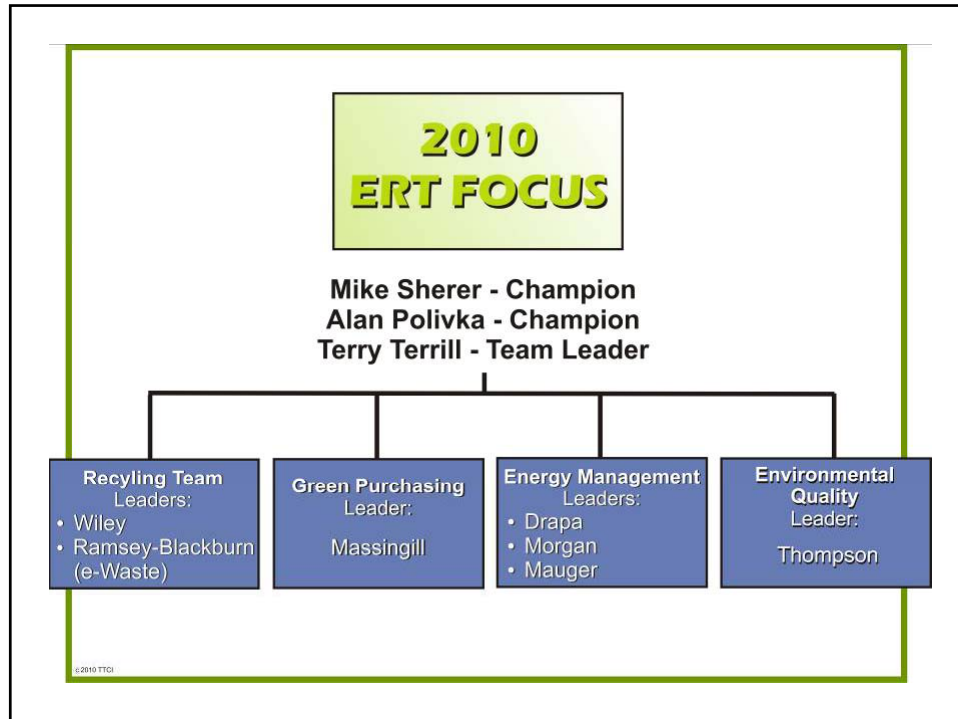

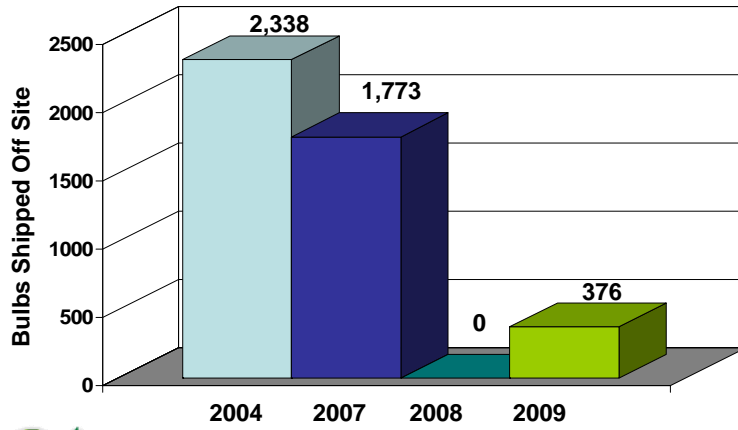


Scrap Metal

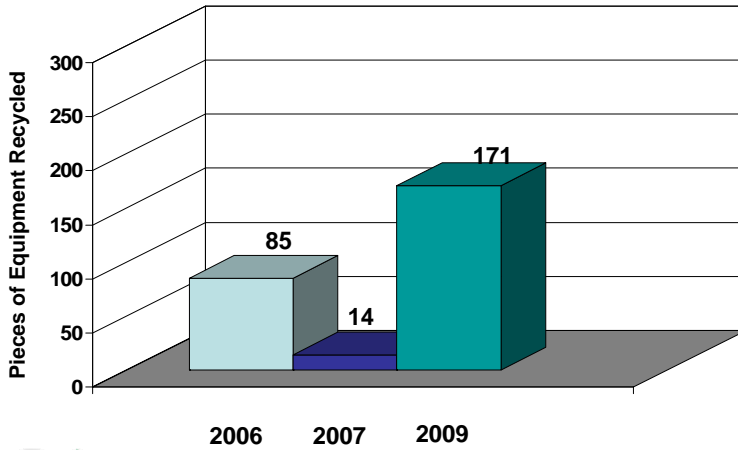


Fluorescent Lamp Recycling



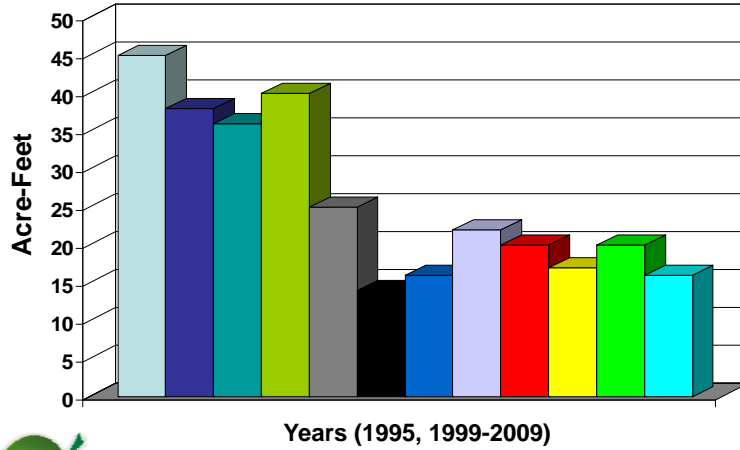

Recycled E-Waste



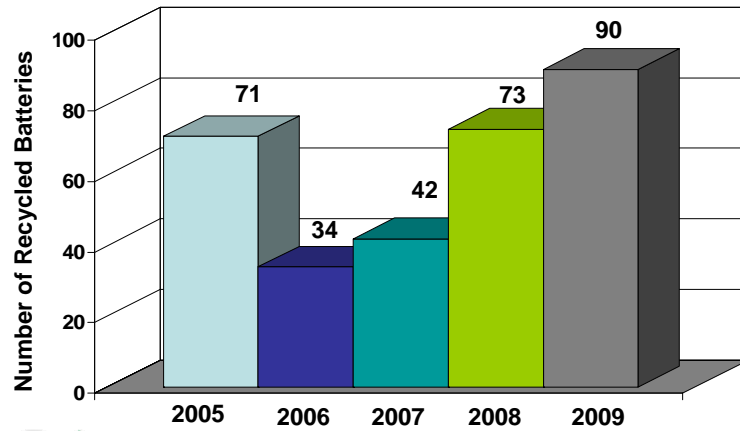

Water Usage in Acre-Feet



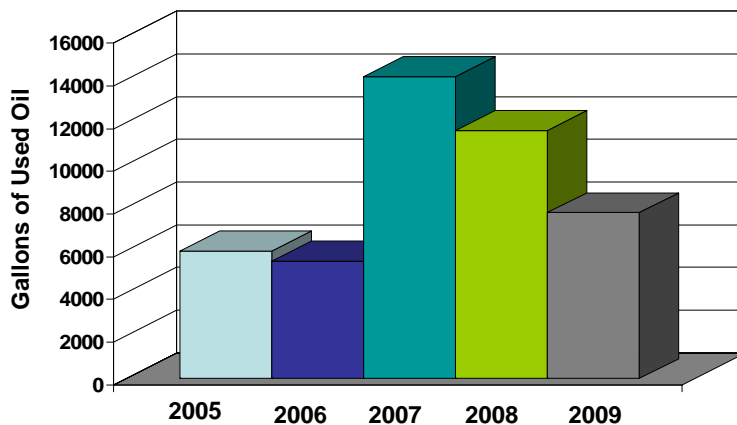
